San Andreas Regional Center is one of 21 regional centers in California. All regional centers are required to meet caseload ratios as stipulated in statute. San Andreas Regional Center is out of compliance with the following requirements:

Issues with compliance:

- a. Staffing formula used by the Department of Developmental Services which is over 25 years old. Social Workers are funded at roughly \$35,000 per year.
- b. Staying competitive in the most expensive area in the state.
- c. San Andreas had over 500 new individuals served in 2018
