



Community Resource Development Plan (CRDP) Priorities FY 2022/2023

Greetings!

The Community Resource Development Plan (CRDP) process is uniquely designed to capture the future funding priorities of our community by surveying those who receive services, their families, our service providers, and other stakeholders.

In early summer, SARC launched the CRDP survey. Again, this year, the survey was designed to explore services needed across age groups and to look at each service in three ways:

- Is more of this service needed?
- Is better quality service needed for this service?
- Is a service needed that looks different from the existing service?

After analyzing the data from this year's survey, the following areas were identified as funding priorities for our community.

- Enhanced Behavioral Home for Children
- Enhanced Behavioral Home for Adults for those charged with sexual offenses
- Memory Care Home
- Behavioral Day Programs
- Behavioral Respite Services
- Supported Living Services in Monterey County

Additionally, the following priority was identified and not met through FY 2021/2022 CRDP funding;

- Enhanced Supported Living Services

Given the funding released from the state this year, our CRDP funding request will reflect the above priorities.
