San Andreas Regional Center Health Insurance Co-pay Mandate

Updated for 2024

For Children in the Early Start Program (ages 0-3)

<u>Welfare and Institutions Code 4659.1</u> was amended in 2019 allowing regional centers to cover co-pays, co-insurance, or deductibles for services specified on the IFSP *regardless of income*, if both conditions below can be met.

- 1. Consumer is covered by an insurance plan
- 2. There is no 3rd party liability for cost of service (i.e. there is not a secondary insurance plan)

For individuals ages 3 and older who receive Lanterman Services

<u>Welfare and Institutions Code 4659.1</u> states that regional centers *may* cover co-pays, co-insurance, or deductibles for services specified on the IPP if all three conditions below can be met.

- 1. Consumer is covered by an insurance plan
- 2. Annual gross income does not exceed 400% of federal poverty level.
- 3. There is no 3rd party liability for cost of service

It then goes on to say that an *exception can be made to the income requirement if family provides proof* of one of the following

- A. <u>Extraordinary event</u> that impacts caregiver's ability to provide care, or pay the copayment (event not specified) or
- B. <u>Catastrophic loss</u> (natural disaster, accident involving major injury to immediate family member) that has direct economic impact,
- C. <u>Significant unreimbursed medical expenses for another child who is also a regional</u> <u>center consumer</u>.

Parents will be required to provide a copy of the prior year's state income tax return. W-2s, payroll stubs or other documents may be required as proof of income.

The table below shows the Regional Center income requirements.

For families/households with more than 8 persons, add \$5,380 for each additional person.
