

## DESCRIPTION

This is an overview of the Title 22 licensing regulations that allow certain medical conditions to be accepted in Community Care Facilities and Day Programs. Focus is on licensed adult facilities. FTM, SLS or ILS settings are not governed by these regulations. SARC Policy/Procedure is presented, as well as discussion of role of the RN Consultant and SARC Service Coordinator in the process.
