 - iv. Steps you have taken in preparation to provide services to SARCsponsored individuals, and
 - v. How you will implement the HCBS Final Rule in providing services to SARC-sponsored individuals.
 - vi. Your Administrator's Certificate (If you plan to operate a licensed day facility)

Each of the described documents must be sent as a separate Word or PDF attachment to your email. Resumes or letters of intent included as in-line text in your email will not be accepted. Please make sure your resume and letter of intent are free of typographical errors prior to submission.

Please note that no more than two (2) individuals from a single agency will be admitted to the DPNVO unless prior approval is obtained from Community Resources Unit Manager, Maggie Pendl. If you are not admitted to or are unable to attend the April DPNVO, you will need to reapply for admission to the next DPNVO.
